For those who haven't entered before, the Mens event is divided



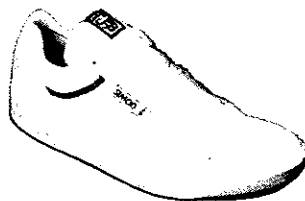

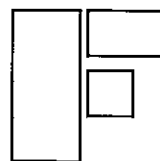
## DEXTERS Middlesex Open Championship, 1986
